The exhibition, *Image of Ukraine*, will feature Vyshyvka (Ukrainian embroidery) and paintings by local Ukrainian artist, Olena Zintchouk, in the style of Petrykivka (a Ukrainian style of painting). Interviews with the Ukrainian community in North Carolina provide a local context, illustrating how well-known forms of folk art can be adapted to new settings and help maintain cultural traditions and identity.
